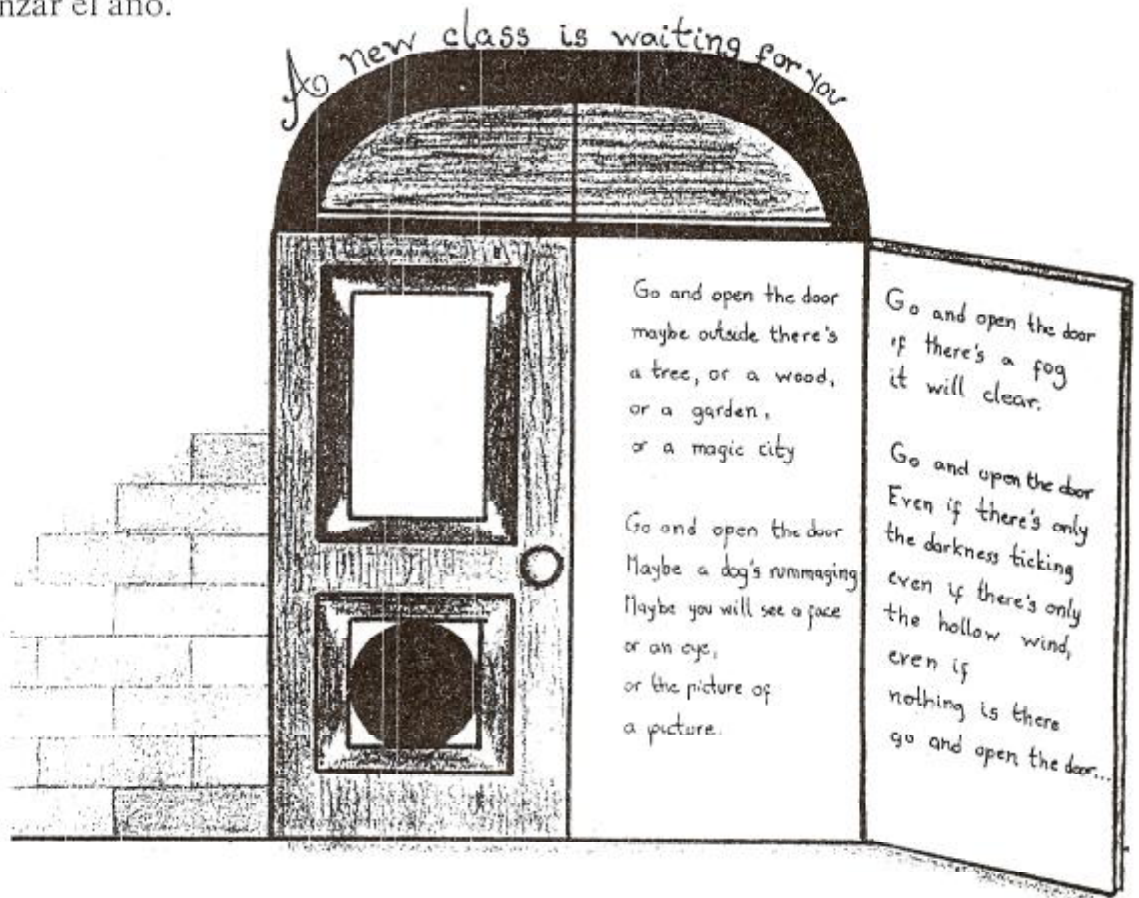

Welcome!!

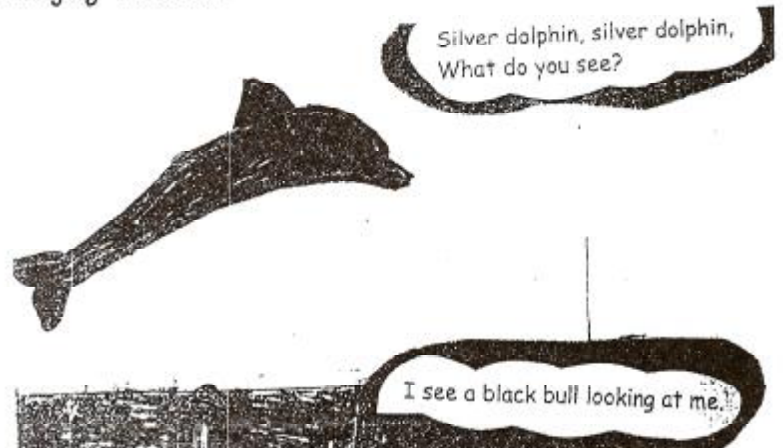
Este es el poema de bienvenida con el que recibimos a los chicos al comenzar el año.

2nd formers made magic wands and became witches and wizards for a day!

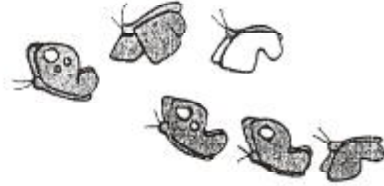
They also tried some of Wizardora's magic spells!
